Amendment of Statement of Principles

concerning

SENSORINEURAL HEARING LOSS

ICD CODE: 389.1

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 subsection 196B(2)

The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(2) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Instrument No.25 of 1994 (Statement of Principles concerning sensorineural hearing loss) by:

- 1. omitting from the heading to the Instrument the words and number, "ICD CODE: 389.10", and inserting in its place, "ICD CODE: 389.1";
- 2. omitting the definition of "sensorineural hearing loss" in clause 4, and inserting in its place the following definition, which reflects the international standard:

"'sensorineural hearing loss' means a permanent hearing threshold shift of at least 25 decibels at either 500, or 1000, or 2000, or 4000 Hertz due to a defect in the cochlea or the auditory nerve whereby nervous impulses from the cochlea to the brain are attenuated, attracting an ICD code of 389.1.".
