Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 subsection 196B(3)

The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(3) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* (the Act), Instrument No.8 of 1994 (Statement of Principles concerning gout) by:

- 1. omitting paragraph 1(e), and inserting in its place the following:
 - "(e) administration to the person of one of the following substances not more than 28 days prior to the clinical worsening of gout:
 - (i) thiazide diuretic; or
 - (ii) acetyl-salicylic acid (aspirin); or
 - (iii) nicotinic acid; or
 - (iv) pyrazinamide; or
 - (v) ethambutol; or"
- 2. omitting paragraph 3, and inserting in its place the following:
 - "3. The factors set out in paragraphs 1(d) to 1(g) apply only where:
 - (a) the person's **gout** was contracted prior to a period, or part of a period, of service to which the factor is related; and
 - (b) the relationship suggested between the **gout** and the particular service of a person is a relationship set out in paragraph 8(1)(e), 9(1)(e) or 70(5)(d) of the Act."
