

Amendment of Statement of Principles
concerning

CERVICAL SPONDYLOSIS

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986

1. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(2) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* (the Act), Instrument No.50 of 2002 by:
 - A. in paragraph 5, deleting factor (g) and factor (s) and inserting in their place the following factors:
 - “(g) suffering an injury to the cervical spine which has resulted in permanent ligamentous instability of the cervical spine before the clinical onset of cervical spondylosis; or”
 - “(s) suffering an injury to the cervical spine which has resulted in permanent ligamentous instability of the cervical spine before the clinical worsening of cervical spondylosis; or”
 - B. in paragraph 8, deleting the definition of “**permanent ligamentous instability**” and inserting in its place the following definition:

“**permanent ligamentous instability of the cervical spine**’ means radiological evidence on flexion and extension lateral radiographs of either:

- (i) anteroposterior motion of one vertebra over another that is greater than 3.5 mm in the cervical spine, or
- (ii) angular motion at the level in question that is more than 11 degrees greater than at either adjacent level;”

2. The amendments made by this instrument apply to all matters to which Instrument No.50 of 2002 and section 120A of the Act apply.
