

Amendment of Statement of Principles

concerning

ACUTE BLEPHARITIS

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986

1. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(2) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* (the Act), Instrument No. 115 of 1995, by:
 - A. in clause 4, deleting the definition of “**irritant substances**”, and inserting in its place the following:

“**irritant substances**’ means substances causing an irritant effect such as dyes, oils, industrial chemicals, tobacco smoke or CS agent;”
2. The amendment made by this instrument applies to all matters to which Instrument No. 115 of 1995, and section 120A of the Act apply.
