

Amendment Statement of Principles

concerning

MORBID OBESITY No. 75 of 2019

for the purposes of the

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

- 1. This Instrument may be cited as Amendment Statement of Principles concerning morbid obesity No. 75 of 2019.
- 2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning morbid obesity Instrument No. 5 of 2014 (Federal Register of Legislation No. F2014L00010) by:
 - (A) Replacing the definition of "morbid obesity" in clause 3(b) as follows:
 - "(b) For the purposes of this Statement of Principles, "morbid obesity" means an excessive accumulation of fat in the body resulting in:
 - (i) a Body Mass Index (BMI) of at least 40; or
 - (ii) in those aged 18 years or younger, a BMI of at least 120 percent of the 97th percentile in the 2007 World Health Organisation Body Mass Index Charts, for Age and Gender."; and
 - (B) Revising the definition of "BMI" in clause 9 as follows:

"BMI" means W/H² where: W is the person's weight in kilograms; and H is the person's height in metres;'.
