Schedule 1 – Dictionary	In paragraph (l) in the definition of "specified list of infections", insert the word "virus" after the word "measles".
Schedule 1 – Dictionary	After paragraph (o) in the definition of "specified list of infections", insert the following paragraph:
	(oa) severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2);
Schedule 1 – Dictionary	Insert the following note to the definition of "specified list of infections":
	Note: SARS-CoV-2 is the virus which causes coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).
